

TOWN OF BERWICK BYLAW

POLICE REGULATIONS

56. The police officers and all special and extra constables appointed by the Council shall be under the direction, control and authority of the Police Committee and of the Mayor.
57. Every police officer or constable shall be prompt and obey and carry out all orders and directions from time to time given by the Mayor or Police Committee and shall serve all processes, civil and criminal, issued out of the Municipal Court and make arrests within the Town when requested by the Town Clerk so to do.
58. The Police Committee shall cause to be entered in a book kept for that purpose any special order or direction in regard to police matters which book shall be in the custody of the Town Clerk and shall be open at all times to the inspection of the police officers and constables in the discharge of their duty and which orders and directions the police officers and constables shall be bound at once to obey and carry out.
59. The Council shall from time to time fix and appoint the fees, salaries and emoluments to be paid to the police officers and constable except such fees as are fixed by Statute.
