Town buildings and facilities are closed to the general public in support of Nova Scotia Health's efforts to limit the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19).

Town of Berwick:

The health and well-being of employees and the general public are the Town's top priorities.

Nova Scotia Health has been providing daily updates about COVID-19; the situation is evolving rapidly. The Town is following the recommendations of authorities and has closed its buildings and facilities to the general public. Recreation programming, the March Break Day Camp, the After School Program and the Fitness Centre are all suspending operations until further notice.

Town administration has carefully reviewed operations that will see the majority of employees working from home via telephone and online. Core services will continue to be provided and the public should be advised that:
