Mark Your Calendars! Remarks from Mayor Clarke

With the changing of the seasons, Berwick's current council enters the fourth and final year of their term. Despite the pandemic-related complications of the first two years, council persevered, and has spent the third year celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Town's incorporation. The centennial celebrations began on New Year's Eve in 2022 and will wrap-up New Year's Eve 2023.

One of the proudest achievements of Berwick over the past century is the community solar garden on which is currently in the Willow Avenue. commissioning stage. Before the year ends, the community solar garden will be producing renewable, green electric energy. This power will become part of our energy mix, at a time when global issues and pressures on energy costs are causing prices to rise substantially. While we may see a short-term increase in Berwick Electric prices, the power generated by the community solar garden will provide a stabilizing effect on the price we have to pay for any power we purchase. With wind power from Ellershouse, hydroelectric power from our Factorydale dam and the new community solar garden, we will be purchasing less and less power from other utilities.

TOWN BRUSH & LEAF CLEAN UP

UNTIL NOV 30: DROP-OFF BIN

A large bin is available at 216 Main Street (Public Works) to drop off your leaves and brush at your convenience.

OCT 16-27: BRUSH PICK-UP NOV 6-10: LEAF PICK-UP

Leaves and brush should be placed curbside no earlier than the previous weekend.

- Leaves must be placed into environmentally friendly paper bags. No plastic!
- Brush is to be cut into 4' lengths and neatly piled. Each residence is limited to one half-ton pick-up size of material, with **one pick-up only** per civic address. For more information call 902-538-8717 or email tharding@berwick.ca

Rules for clean up

- Residents should have items out no later than 7AM on the Monday, October 16.
- The truck will be along once during that week.
 There is no specified day.
- Please remove batteries from items.
- Bagged items must be in clear bags.
- Maximum of 20 items will be collected.
- Items not collected are the residents responsibility and must be removed from roadside when cleanup is finished.
- No recyclables, cardboard or yard waste. These can be included with your regular garbage.
