1. Call to Order

The Police Advisory Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm.

4. Reports:

a. Sgt Ryan Kelly

Sgt. Ryan Kelly reviewed the Police Report for September/October, 2019.

Sgt. Kelly highlighted that there were a total of 140 service calls in the Town of Berwick during October.

b. Ella Redden, Bylaw Officer

Ms. Redden reviewed her report indicating the community response to her position has been very positive. Ella has been dealing with many issues such as animal complaints, occupancy issue and dangerous and unsightly.

5. Foster Street and Union Street Intersection

Mr. Payne identified some citizen concerns with regard to the safety of this intersection (traffic, line of sight issues). This issue is going to COTW in November for Council discussion and perhaps a recommendation for improving the safety issues in the area.

6. Orchard Street Radar Data

Mr. Payne reviewed the August radar data report for Orchard Street. Data confirms there are a number of speeding vehicles; the maximum over speeds averaged approximately 60-65 km/hr.

This radar sign has now been moved to Foster Street, near Union Street.
