### **1. Call to Order**

The Police Advisory Meeting was called to order at 4:35pm.

### **2. Approval of Minutes:**

The previous minutes were approved as circulated.

### **3. Approval of the Agenda**

### **4. Reports:**

#### **a. Sgt Ryan Kelly**

Sgt. Ryan Kelly reviewed the Police Report for January-February. Sgt. Kelly highlighted that in the month of February, Kings District responded to 908 service calls. There were a total of 64 calls in the Town of Berwick during this period.

### **5. Pertinent Updates**

Sgt. Kelly noted that there has been radar set up on Main Street, recording no speeders during these times.

Mr. Payne has talked to Eden Valley on a few occasions with regard to the elevated speed of employees on Main Street. Mike will have more data from the speed signs at the May meeting.

This month the members are focusing on seatbelt enforcement. In April members will highlight driving/speeding enforcement.

Mr. Payne explained, once again, that the Town encourages RCMP visibility in town.
